LETTER DATED 24 NOVEMBER 1967 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF CYPRUS ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

Upon instructions received from my Government, I have the honour to request Your Excellency to be good enough to convene an immediate emergency meeting of the Security Council, as a matter of the utmost urgency, in view of the clear threat of imminent invasion of the territory of the Republic of Cyprus by Turkish forces.

The Security Council will be called upon to consider the matter and to take forthwith appropriate measures, under the relevant provisions of the Charter, for the purpose of everting the imminent invasion and protecting and safeguarding the territorial integrity of the Republic of Cyprus.
