NOTE VERBALE DATED 26 JANUARY 1967 FROM THE MINISTRY OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS OF DAHOMEY ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL*

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs presents its compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and has the honour to refer to the Secretary-General's notes No. PO 230 SORH (1) of 17 December 1966 and 13 January 1967 concerning the measures taken by the Government of Dahomey for the implementation of resolution S/RES/232 (1966) adopted by the Security Council on 16 December 1966 concerning the situation in Southern Rhodesia.

The Ministry informs the Secretary-General that, in conformity with decisions of the Organization of African Unity, the Government of Dahomey, by Decree No. 15 bis/PR/MAE/AP dated 12 January 1966, had already taken certain measures in line with Security Council resolution S/RES/232 (1966) as follows:

All economic dealings with Rhodesia, direct or through an intermediary, are prohibited throughout the territory of the Republic of Dahomey;

Ships and aircraft flying the Rhodesian flag or registered in Rhodesia, and ships and aircraft proceeding from or to Rhodesia, are prohibited from stopping at Dahomean ports and airfields or overflying Dahomean territory;

No transit or entry visas for the territory of the Republic of Dahomey are granted to white Rhodesians except in special circumstances at the discretion of the competent Dahomean authorities.

The reply to the questionnaire on imports and exports of the products enumerated in operative paragraph 2 of the Security Council resolution will be transmitted to the Secretary-General as soon as possible.

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs avails itself, etc.
