NOTE VERBALE DATED 11 FEBRUARY 1966 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF THE DOMINICAN REPUBLIC ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL.

The Permanent Representative of the Dominican Republic to the United Nations presents his compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and, in reply to the Secretary-General's note No. FO 230 SORH (1) of 29 November 1965 concerning Security Council resolution 217 (1965) on Southern Rhodesia, has the honour to state that the Provisional Government of the Dominican Republic does not intend to recognize the present regime in Southern Rhodesia and has taken steps to break all ties with that country, including the issuance of instructions to the competent departments not to accept as valid the travel documents issued by the illegal authorities of Southern Rhodesia.

The Permanent Representative of the Dominican Republic to the United Nations requests the Secretary-General to have this note circulated as an official document of the General Assembly and the Security Council and takes this opportunity, etc.
