LETTER DATED 14 JUNE 1966 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF CAMBODIA
ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

On the instructions of my Government I have the honour to communicate the following to you for the information of the members of the Security Council.

On 4 June 1966 an engineering appliance which was part of a convoy leaving the phum of Chrung, srok of Samrong, province of Oddor Meanchey, was blown up on a mine laid by elements of the Thai armed forces in the neighbourhood of the aforementioned phum, which is situated some eight kilometres within our territory.

Two of our soldiers and two soldiers' wives were seriously wounded.

I should be obliged if you would be good enough to have the text of this communication circulated as a Security Council document.
