REPORT OF THE SECRETARY-GENERAL TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE
SECURITY COUNCIL CONCERNING THE CREDENTIALS OF THE
REPRESENTATIVE OF VENEZUELA TO THE SECURITY COUNCIL

Pursuant to rules 14 and 15 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the Secretary-General wishes to report that he has received a letter dated 16 June 1966 from the Permanent Representative of Venezuela transmitting credentials from the Minister for External Relations of Venezuela appointing Mr. Pedro Zuloaga as representative and Mr. Tulio Alvarado as alternate representative of Venezuela to the Security Council during its consideration of the application of Guyana for admission to the United Nations.

In the opinion of the Secretary-General, this communication constitutes adequate credentials.
