LETTER DATED 6 JANUARY 15% FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF INDIA ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

I have the honour to communicate the following further cease-fire violations and other incidents created by Fakistan:

Jammu and Kashmir

Keran Sector

(1) Fakistani troops fired 3-inch and 81 mm mortars and light machine-guns towards two of our posts in Ringpain area on 30 December 1965.

Kargil Sector

(2) Pakistani troops were seen repairing bunkers in an area five and a balf miles north-north-west of Kargil on 2 January 1966.

Tithwal Sector

(3) Pakistani troops were observed digging in an area eight miles northnorth-east of Tithwal on 31 December 1965.

(4) Fakistani troops fired 81 cm mortars towards an area four miles northnorth-east of Tithwal on the night of 1/2 January 1966.

Uri Sector

(5) Pakistani troops were seen constructing bunkers in an area six and a half miles south-south-west of Haji Pir Pass on 50 December 1965.

Punch Sector

(6) Pakistani troops were seen digging in an area six miles west-north-west of Punch on 30 December 1965.

 (7) Pakistani troops were observed digging in an area five miles west-northwest of Punch on 31 December 1965.

(8) Pakistani troops were observed digging in areas five and six miles northwest of Funch on 1 January 1966.

(9) Pakistani troops were observed digging trenches in an area six and a half miles west-north-west of Punch on 2 January 1966.

(10) Pakistani troops fired light machine-guns towards an area four and a quarter miles west-south-west of Funch on 2 January 1966.

Mendhar Sector

(11) Pakistani troops fired at our patrol in an area four and a half miles west of Galuthi on 30 December 1965.

(12) Pakistani troops were observed digging in an area six and a half miles south-west of Galuthi on 31 December 1965.

(15) Two newly built Pakistani bunkers were observed in an area one and three quarter miles west-north-west of Balnoi on 31 December 1965.

(14) Pakistani troops fired as under on the night or 31 December 1965/ 1 January 1966:

(a) 81 mm mortars towards our posts in areas six miles and six and a half miles south-west of Galuthi.

(b) Small arms towards our patrol in an area four and a half miles southwest of Galuthi.

(15) Pakistani troops fired 3.7-inch howitzers towards two of our posts in areas five miles west-north-west and three miles west-south-west of Galuthi on 1 January 1966.

(16) Pakistani troops fired 3.7-inch howitzers towards two of our posts in areas six miles west-north-west and four and a quarter miles west-south-west of Galuthi on 2 January 1966.

Rajauri Sector

(17) Three Pakistani troops intruded on our side of the Cease-Fire-Line in an area eight miles west-north-west of Rajauri on 50 December 1965.

(18) One Pakistani F-104 aircraft flew over an area fifteen miles couth-west of Jammu to fifteen miles east-north-east of Udhampur at 1329 hours to 1357 hours on 28 December 1965.

(19) Fakistani troops were observed digging in an area eight and a half miles west-north-west of Rajauri on 31 December 1965.

Naushahra Sector

(20) Pakistani troops were seen constructing bunkers in an area eight and three guarter miles south-west of Naushahra on 50 December 1965.

(21) Approximately ten Pakistani troops intruded on our side of the Cease-Fire Line in areas five miles north-east and two and a half miles north of Jhangar on 50 December 1965.

(22) Pakistani troops were observed digging in an area two and a half miles north of Jhangar on 51 Pecember 1965.

(23) Five Fakistani troops were observed digging in an area three miles north-west of Jhangar on 1 January 1966.

(24) Approximately ten Pakistani troops intruded on our side of the Cease-Fire Line and started digging in an area four miles north-east of Jhangar on 51 December 1965.

(25) Five Pakistani personnel were seen digging on our side of the Cease-Fire Line in an area three miles north-east of Jhangar on 1 January 1966.

(26) Pakistani troops were seen constructing bunkers in an area three and a half miles west of Jhangar on 2 January 1966.

Akhnur Sector

(27) Pakistani troops were seen digging and improving defences in two places in general area five and a half uiles north-east of Kalit on 29/50 December 1965.

(28) Pakistani troops were seen digging and improving defences in three places between two and a half miles south-east and six miles west-north-west of Kalidhar on 50 December 1965.

(29) Pakistani troops were observed strengthening their defences as under:

(a) In an area five and a half miles north-east of Kalit on 31 December 1965.

(b) In an area two and three quarter miles south-west of Kalidhar on 51 December 1965 and 1 January 1966.

(c) In an area six wiles west of Kalidhar on 1 January 1966.

(30) Pakistani patrol fired two bursts of light machine-guns on our police patrol in an area four and a half miles south-south-west of Akhnur on 1 January 1966.

(31) Pakistani troops were seen improving defences in an area six and a half miles north-north-east of Jaurian on 2 January 1966.

Punjab

Sialkot Sector

(32) Our patrol in an area two miles north-north-west of Sukho Chak observed Pakistani civilians crossing the international border in an area twelve miles south-south-east of Samba and cutting grass and crops at 1500 hours on 30 December 1965. On being warned to return, they opened fire.

(53) Three Pakistani civilians intruded into our territory in an area four and three quarter miles west-north-west of R.S. Fura on 29 December 1965, and were apprehended.

(34) Pakistani troops fired rifles and light machine-guns towards our police post in an area four and a half miles east-south-east of Ramgarh at 2359 hours on 30 December 1965.

(35) Pakistani troops fired light machine-guns at our patrol in an area six miles north-west of Chawinda on the night of 1/2 January 1966.

(36) Pakistani troops fired one tracer towards our post in an area five miles north-north-east of Zafarwal on 2 January 1966.

Lahore Sector

(37) Pakistani troops, approximately one platoon, were observed digging and laying mines in an area two and a half miles west-south-west of Manhiala on 30 December 1965.

(38) Pakistani troops fired one light machine-gun burst towards our post in an area one and a half miles north-west of Jahman on 50 December 1965.

(39) Pakistani troops fired as under:

(a) One rifle shot each at two of our posts in areas one and a half miles and two miles south-south-west of Bhasin on 31 December 1965.

(b) One light machine-gun burst at our post one and a half miles north-west of Jahman on 31 December 1965.

(c) One rifle shot towards our post in an area two miles south-south-west of Earki on 31 December 1965.

(d) Light machine-guns towards our positions in areas three and four miles south of Borki on 2 January 1986.

(40) Pakistani troops were seen digging and forming in pickets for laying mines on the east bank of Ichhogil Canal in an area two and a half miles southwest of Manhiala on 31 December 1965.

(41) Pakistani troops were observed doing the following:

(a) Constructing bunkers and pillboxes in areas 1,200 yards west-south-west and one mile west of Bhasin on 2 January 1966.

(b) Unloading bricks and ballies at three places near Bhasin on 2 January 1966.

(c) Improving shelters in an area one and a quarter miles west-south-west of Khemkaran on 2 January 1966.

(42) Pakistani troops fired light machine-guns towards our ratrol base in an arca four miles north-north-west of Jahman on the night of 1/2 January 1966.

(43) Pakistani troops fired light machine-guns towards our position in an area three miles south of Barki on the night of 1/2 January 1966.

(44) Pakistani troops fired with rifles towards our observation post in an area four miles north of Khemkaran on 1 January 1966.

Fazilka Sector

(1:5) Pakistani troops fired small arms towards our post Wal Singhwala seven miles north-north-uest of Jalalabad on 29 December 1965.

(46) Pakistani troops fired as under:

(a) Two 2-inch mortar bombs at our post three miles north-north-west of Mandot on 30 December 1965.

(b) Small arms towards our post in an area five and a half miles north-west of Jalalabad on 50 December 1965.

(c) Three rifle shots towards our post in an area eight miles south-southwest of Fazilka on 30 December 1965.

(d) Two rifle shots towards our observation post in an area five and a half miles south-east of Rajoke on 1 January 1966.

(e) Small arms towards our patrol in an area four miles west-south-west of Mamdot on 31 December 1965.

(f) Small arms towards our posts in an area five and a quarter miles northwest of Jalalabad on 30 December 1965. S/7070 English Page 6

(g) Three rifle shots towards an area two and a quarter miles south of Chananuala on 50 December 1965.

(47) Pakistani troops fired light machine-guns towards our post in an area seven miles north-north-east of Mandot on 1 January 1966.

(43) Pakistani troops fired one rifle shot towards our post in an area three miles north-west of Fazilka on 2 January 1966.

Rajasthan

(49) Pakistani patrol fired at our patrol in an area thirteen miles southsouth-uest of Tenot on 30 December 1965.

Cease-fire violation complaints have been or are being lodged in respect of all these violations.

I shall be grateful if this communication is circulated as a Security Council document.
