LETTER DATED 22 FEBRUARY 1966 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE
OF GREECE ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

Following my letter No. P3365-177 dated 12 February 1966,^{1/} I have the honour to inform you that the Turkish Air Force has committed two new violations of Greek air space, under the circumstances described below.

On 20 February 1966, at 16.30 hours, local time, five Turkish jet aircraft, flying in formation, and at very low altitude, violated Greek air space 150 metres north-east of Nea Vyssi, Orestias.

On the same day, at 11:15 hours local time, a Turkish aircraft flew over the northern shores of the island of Mytilini, and penetrated five miles inland. The overflight over Greek territory lasted three minutes. The aircraft then flew eastwards, and re-entered Turkish air space at 11.17 hours.

I would be grateful if Your Excellency could have this letter circulated as a Security Council document.
