LETTER DATED 18 FEBRUARY 1956 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF LUXERPOURG ADDRESSED TO THE SECHETARY-GENERAL

I have the honour to refer to my letter No. A.1.16/495 of 15 December 1965, issued as Security Council document 5/7055, concerning measures taken by Luxembourg pursuant to Security Council resolution 217 (1965) of 20 November 1965.

I have the honour to inform you that the Luxembourg Government has decided, after consultation with its BENELUX partners, to extend the above-mentioned measures by decreeing a total embargo on all new imports originating in Southern Rhodesia. Only earlier contracts which are already being executed may be honoured. These measures will take effect on today's date.

Please circulate this letter as an official document of the Security Council. Accept, Sir, etc.
