LETTER DATED 18 FEBRUARY 1966 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE
OF BELGIUM TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

Sir,

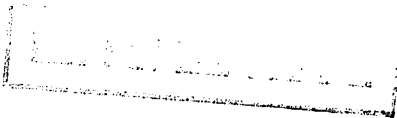
In my letter of 22 December 1965^{1/} I informed you of the measures which the Belgian Government had decided to take in support of the action undertaken by the United Nations with regard to Southern Rhodesia, pursuant to resolution 2022 (XX) adopted by the General Assembly on 5 November 1965, as also resolution 217 (1965) adopted by the Security Council on 20 November 1965.

I have the honour to inform you that, further to the measures indicated above, the Belgian Government, after consultation with its Benelux partners, has decided to extend the ban on imports to all products originating in Southern Rhodesia. Only earlier contracts already being executed may be honoured.

I should be grateful if you would have this letter circulated as an official document of the Security Council and the General Assembly.
