LETTER DATED 19 APRIL 1967 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF CAMBODIA ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

On the instructions of my Government, and further to my letter No. 2239 of 6 April 1967, I have the honour to inform you that the Cambodian Senior Sergeant, Pech Kim An, who was seriously wounded on 11 March 1967 by the explosion of a booby trap set by Thai elements on Khmer territory, in the Srok of Thmar Puok, province of Battambang, died of his wounds on 16 March 1967 at about 7 a.m. at the Preah Monivong hospital at Phnom-Penh.

I should be grateful if you would have the text of this communication circulated as a Security Council document.
