LETTER DATED 29 MAY 1967 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF CAMBODIA
ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

On the instruction of my Government and further to my letter No. 3408 of 22 May 1967, I have the honour to bring the following to your attention for the information of the Security Council.

During the night of 30 April 1967, at about 9.30 p.m., the Khmer military positions established at Kauk-Prich in the Battambang area were violently attacked by unidentified members of the Thai armed forces, who killed a Cambodian defender.

In the face of a vigorous riposte from our defenders, the Thai aggressors withdrew towards their own territory about an hour after the initiation of the engagement.

The Royal Government of Cambodia has registered a strong protest against this new criminal act of aggression committed by Thai forces and has demanded that the Royal Government of Thailand should put an immediate end to these acts of armed provocation on Khmer territory.
