LETTER DATED 3 MARCH 1966 FROM THE SECRETARY-GENERAL ADDRESSED TO THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF BRAZIL TO THE UNITED NATIONS

I have the honour to acknowledge receipt of your letter of 25 February 1966 concerning certain information, set forth in my reports of 10 and 12 February to the Security Council (S/7032/Add.12 and 13), regarding an incident which took place in Santo Domingo on 10 February involving Brazilian military personnel.

I have discussed the matter you have raised in your letter with my representative in the Dominican Republic, Mr. José Antonio Mayobre, and I am happy to assure you that there is no doubt in our minds about the accuracy of the explanation of the incident given in the statement issued by General Alvaro Alves da Silva Braga, Commander of the Inter-American Peace Force. This statement, as you have noted, has been reproduced verbatim in my report of 12 February (S/7032/Add.13, para. 3).

Your letter of 25 February has been circulated to the Council as you requested. This reply will also be circulated.
