LETTER DATED 9 MARCH 1966 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF CYPRUS  
ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

With reference to my letter of even number dated 7 March 1966, I wish to clarify that the Turkish Embassy's direct involvement in the acts of sabotage described therein was through Mr. Kemal Coskun, Attaché of the aforementioned Embassy, inasmuch as the second person implicated in the terrorist activities, Halil Pasha, is the Director of the "Turkish Information Office", which operated under the Turkish-Cypriot extremist leadership. Consequently, the Turkish-Cypriot leadership's involvement is thus also established.

Your Excellency is kindly requested to have this letter circulated as a document of the Security Council.
