NCTE VERBALE DATED 24 FEBRUARY 1966 FROM THE PERMANENT MISSION OF POLAND ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

The Permanent Mission of the Polish People's Republic to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and referring to its note of 14 January 1966, $\frac{1}{2}$ has the honour to state the following:

Pursuant to resolution 2022 (XX) adopted by the General Assembly on 5 November 1965 and resolution 217 (1965) adopted by the Security Council on 20 November 1965 concerning the situation in Southern Rhodesia, the Government of the Polish People's Republic has decided to suspend all the telecommunications and mail service with Southern Rhodesia.

In accordance with binding international conventions, the above-mentioned decision was announced in cables sent by the Polish Ministry of Telecommunications to the General Secretariat of the International Telecommunication Union and the Bureau of the Universal Postal Union.

It would be appreciated if this note were circulated as an official document of the General Assembly and of the Security Council.
