NOTE VERBALE DATED 11 MARCH 1966 FROM THE PERMANENT MISSION
OF ROMANIA ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

The Permanent Mission of the Socialist Republic of Romania to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and, upon the instructions of the Romanian Government, has the honour to inform him the following, in reference with the application by the German Democratic Republic for membership in the United Nations.

The Socialist Republic of Romania fully supports the application by the German Democratic Republic for membership in the United Nations. The German Democratic Republic, a sovereign and peace-loving State, has accepted the requirements contained in the United Nations Charter and is capable and ready to meet them.

The admission of the German Democratic Republic to United Nations membership will constitute a step ahead for the implementation of the universality of the Organization - an important condition for the strengthening of the efficacy of the United Nations as an instrument of peace and international co-operation, called, in accordance with the principles of the Charter, to base its activity on the equal participation of all States, great and small.

The Permanent Mission of the Socialist Republic of Romania would appreciate it if necessary steps could be taken to circulate this letter as an official Security Council document.
