REPORT OF THE SECRETARY-GENERAL TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL CONCERNING THE CREDENTIALS OF AN ALTERNATE REPRESENTATIVE OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA ON THE SECURITY COUNCIL

1. Pursuant to rule 15 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the Secretary-General wishes to report that he has received a note dated 12 March 1966 from the representative of the United States of America, transmitting the text of a telegram from the Secretary of State of the United States to the Secretary-General which states that Mr. James Roosevelt has been designated to serve as representative of the United States of America on the Security Council in the absence of Ambassadors Goldberg, Yost and Nabrit.

2. In the opinion of the Secretary-General, this telegram constitutes adequate provisional credentials.
