LETTER DATED 2 MAY 1967 FROM THE CHARGE D'AFFAIRES a.i. OF
LEBANON ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

I have the honour to refer to your notes No. PO 230 SORH (1) dated 17 December 1966 and 20 March 1967, regarding resolution S/RES/232 (1966) adopted by the Security Council on 16 December 1966, on the question concerning the situation in Southern Rhodesia. Upon instructions received from my Government I wish to state the following:

The Government of Lebanon has already taken the necessary measures in implementation of the provisions of Security Council resolution S/RES/232 (1966). It has severed all economic and trade relations with the illegal régime in Southern Rhodesia, a régime that the Government of Lebanon in pursuance of the Security Council resolution S/RES/217 of 20 November 1965 had decided not to recognize.

I would be grateful to you if you would have this letter circulated as a Security Council document.
