LETTER DATED 2 MAY 1967 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF FINLAND
ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

With reference to your note No. PO 230 SORH (1) of 17 December 1966 concerning resolution S/RES/232 (1966) adopted by the Security Council on 16 December 1966 on the question of Southern Rhodesia, and to my letter No. 371 of 17 February 1967, in which I informed you that the Government of Finland had submitted to Parliament a bill regarding the implementation of the above-mentioned Security Council resolution, I am now in the position to inform you that the Parliament of Finland has passed this bill and that accordingly the Government of Finland has taken all necessary measures in order to implement fully the provisions of resolution S/RES/232 (1966).

I should be grateful if this letter could be circulated as an official document of the Security Council.
