REPORT BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL
CONCERNING THE CREDENTIALS OF THE REPRESENTATIVE OF URUGUAY ON THE
SECURITY COUNCIL

Pursuant to rule 15 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the Secretary-General wishes to report that he has received credentials signed on 14 February 1966 by the President of the National Council of Government of Uruguay and by the Minister of External Relations, stating that the National Council of Government has appointed Dr. Pedro P.
