REPORT BY THE SECRETARY GENERAL TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL CONCERNING THE CREDENTIALS OF THE REPRESENTIVES OF SYRIA TO THE SECURITY COUNCIL

Pursuant to rules 14 and 15 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the Secretary-General wishes to report that he has received a telegram dated 28 May 1967 from the Minister for Foreign Affairs of the Syrian Arab Republic, stating that Dr. Tomeh and Dr. Adib Daoudy have been appointed to represent Syria in the Security Council's discussion concerning the Palestine question or any related matter.

In the opinion of the Secretary-General, this telegram constitutes adequate provisional credentials.
