Statement made on 1 December 1988 by the Twelve member States of the European Community on the Sudan

[Original: English/French]

The Twelve welcome the latest efforts undertaken towards peace in the south of the Sudan. They urge all parties concerned to build on these efforts to conclude an early cease-fire so that peace can be restored and relief operations and reconstruction in the Sudan - particularly in the south - can get under way.
