While the Australian Mission to the United Nations is not yet able to provide a list of experts, it recalls that an Australian expert, Dr. Dunn, did participate in United Nations investigations into the use of chemical weapons. The Australian Mission is, however, able to advise that the Australian Department of Defence Materials Research Laboratory is the nominated facility capable of testing for chemical warfare agents.
