LETTER DATED 13 MAY 1966 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF INDIA
ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

I have the honour to state that the Government and people of India are very concerned about the grave situation now prevailing in Southern Rhodesia and are keen to co-operate with the Security Council in its labours on the question of Southern Rhodesia.

I am, therefore, to request you, under instructions from my Government, to permit me, in accordance with Article 31 of the Charter of the United Nations and the relevant rules of the provisional rules of the Security Council, to participate in the proceedings of the Council concerning Southern Rhodesia.
