Tunisia\*: draft resolution

Preparations for an international development strategy for  
the fourth United Nations development decade

The General Assembly,

Recalling its resolution 42/193 of 11 December 1987 and Economic and Social Council resolution 1988/76 of 29 July 1988 on an international development strategy for the fourth United Nations development decade,

1. Decides to establish an ad hoc committee of the whole for the preparation of the new international development strategy, and requests the ad hoc committee to submit a progress report to the General Assembly at its forty-fourth session for its consideration, with a view to finalizing the strategy in time for adoption in 1990;
2. Invites the Committee for Development Planning to continue its activities related to the consideration of the strategy in support of the work of the ad hoc committee;
3. Invites the United Nations Conference on Trade and Development, the regional commissions and other organizations and specialized agencies of the United Nations system to include in their agenda during 1989 items regarding their contribution to the preparation of the international development strategy;

4. Requests the Secretary-General of the United Nations Conference on Trade and Development and the executive heads of the other organs, organizations, and bodies of the United Nations system to contribute effectively to the preparatory process for the strategy by providing all appropriate input, including relevant documentation, using comprehensive analytical studies;

5. Requests, in this context, the Secretary-General to entrust the Director-General for Development and International Economic Co-operation with the responsibility for overall co-ordination of the contributions of relevant secretariats of the United Nations system to the formulation of the strategy.

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
