NOTE VERBALE DATED 4 FEBRUARY 1966 FROM THE FERMANENT MISSION OF THE HASHFMITE KINGDOM OF JORDAN ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

The Permanent Mission of the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and has the honour to refer to the Mission's note No. 1/330 dated 6 January 1966, concerning Security Council resolution 217 (1965), regarding the situation in Southern Rhodesia, and to inform the Secretary-General that in addition to breaking all economic relations with Southern Rhodesia and applying complete economic boycott against her, the Jordanian Government will not entertain any diplomatic or other relations with the illegal authority in Southern Rhodesia.

The Permanent Mission of Jordan would appreciate it very much if this note is circulated as a document of the General Assembly and of the Security Council.
