LETTER DATED 18 JULY 1966 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF MEXICO ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

With reference to the various resolutions adopted by the Security Council on the situation in Southern Rhodesia, particularly the resolution adopted on 20 November 1965, acting on instructions received from my Government, I have the honour to inform you as follows:

With effect from 50 June 1966, all exports of arms, equipment and military material to the territory of Southern Rhodesia and all exports of petroleum and its derivatives have been prohibited; all economic relations with Southern Rhodesia have been severed and, with effect from that date, persons holding passports or other documents issued by the authorities of Southern Rhodesia will be refused authorization to enter Mexico.

I should be obliged if you would arrange to have this letter circulated as a Security Council document.
