A. PROPOSAL

Paragraph 6.2.7., amend to read:

"

Dipped-beam headlamps **shall** be switched ON or OFF automatically. However, it shall be always possible to switch these dipped-beam headlamps ON and OFF manually."

B. JUSTIFICATION

During its fifty-second session, GRE considered the proposal TRANS/WP.29/GRE/2004/5 regarding the reduction of DRL illumination surface. At that session, the expert from Germany expressed his preference to insert into the proposal provisions for an <u>automatic switching of dipped beam headlamps</u> as well as for transitional provisions. Thus, the German delegation suggests the above-mentioned amendments to the existing text of the Regulation for consideration by GRE at its fifty-third session.
