IAPSO annual statistical report 2003

Procurement of goods and services, international project personnel, UNV volunteers, and fellowships

- 1. The present report, covering procurement data of the United Nations system, is submitted by the Administrator to the Executive Board pursuant to its decision 96/2. The report may be obtained in the language of submission (English only) from the Executive Board secretariat on CD-ROM or downloaded from the Inter-Agency Procurement Services Office site at www.iapso.org/information/publications.asp.
- 2. The main purpose of the report is to provide details on procurement by country of supply to the United Nations system.
- 3. Total procurement by the United Nations system under all sources of funding during 2003 was \$5.08 billion, the share of procurement from developing countries was 45.1 per cent, which shows a steady increase over the past few years. Under UNDP funding, the total procurement in 2003 was \$825.6 million and the share of procurement from developing countries was 78.3, an increase of 4.2 per cent.
- 4. The annual statistical report 2003 features the following sections:
- (a) A section covering major equipment (more than \$30 000) and services procured by the United Nations system;
- (b) List of top ten product groups/items procured by the United Nations system;
- (c) Summary sheets of the Member countries of the Development Assistance Committee of the Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development;
- (d) Graphical representation of the top ten contributors to UNDP regular resources and their respective procurement volumes;
- (e) Procurement under the direct execution modality is now reflected in greater detail in the report.
