Summary statement by the Secretary-General on matters of which the Security Council is seized and on the stage reached in their consideration

Addendum

Pursuant to rule 11 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the Secretary-General is submitting the following summary statement.

The Security Council resumed its consideration of the item at its 4983rd (private) meeting, held on 7 June 2004 in accordance with the understanding reached in its prior consultations.

At the close of the meeting, in accordance with rule 55 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the following communiqué was issued through the Secretary-General in place of a verbatim record:

“On 7 June 2004, the Security Council, pursuant to annex II, sections A and B, of resolution 1353 (2001), held its 4983rd meeting in private with the troop-contributing countries to the United Nations Peacekeeping Force in Cyprus (UNFICYP).

“The Security Council and the troop-contributing countries heard a briefing under rule 39 of its provisional rules of procedure by Wolfgang Weisbrod-Weber, Acting Director of the Europe and Latin America Division of the Department of Peacekeeping Operations.”

The Security Council resumed its consideration of the item at its 4984th and 4987th meetings, held on 7 and 8 June 2004, respectively, in accordance with the understanding reached in its prior consultations.

At the 4984th meeting, in accordance with the understanding reached in the Council's prior consultations, the President, with the consent of the Council, extended an invitation under rule 39 of the Council's provisional rules of procedure to Lakhdar Brahimi, Special Adviser to the Secretary-General.

At the 4987th meeting, the President, with the consent of the Council, invited the representative of Iraq, at his request, to participate in the discussion without the right to vote.

The President drew attention to a draft resolution (S/2004/460) submitted by Romania, the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the United States of America.

The Security Council proceeded to vote on draft resolution S/2004/460, and adopted it unanimously as resolution 1546 (2004) (for the text, see S/RES/1546 (2004); to be issued in *Official Records of the Security Council, Resolutions and Decisions of the Security Council, 1 August 2003-31 July 2004*).

The situation concerning the Democratic Republic of the Congo (*see*

The Security Council resumed its consideration of the item at its 4986th and 4989th meetings, held on 8 and 11 June 2004, respectively, in accordance with the understanding reached in its prior consultations. At the 4986th meeting, the Council had before it the report of the Secretary-General on his mission of good offices in Cyprus (S/2004/437); at the 4989th meeting, the Council had before it the report of the Secretary-General on the United Nations operation in Cyprus (S/2004/427).

At the 4986th meeting, in accordance with the understanding reached in the Council's prior consultations, the President, with the consent of the Council, extended an invitation under rule 39 of the Council's provisional rules of procedure to Alvaro de Soto, Under-Secretary-General and Special Adviser to the Secretary-General on Cyprus.

At the 4989th meeting, the President drew attention to a draft resolution (S/2004/484) submitted by the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland.

The Security Council proceeded to vote on draft resolution S/2004/484, and adopted it unanimously as resolution 1548 (2004) (for the text, see S/RES/1548 (2004); to be issued in *Official Records of the Security Council, Resolutions and Decisions of the Security Council, 1 August 2003-31 July 2004*).

Report of the Secretary-General on the Sudan (*see also* S/2003/40/Add.40; and S/2004/20/Add.21)

The Security Council met to consider the item at its 4988th meeting, held on 11 June 2004 in accordance with the understanding reached in its prior consultations, having before it the report of the Secretary-General on the Sudan (S/2004/453).

The President, with the consent of the Council, invited the representative of the Sudan, at his request, to participate in the discussion without the right to vote.

The President drew attention to a draft resolution (S/2004/473) submitted by the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland.

The Security Council proceeded to vote on draft resolution S/2004/473, and adopted it unanimously as resolution 1547 (2004) (for the text, see S/RES/1547 (2004); to be issued in *Official Records of the Security Council, Resolutions and Decisions of the Security Council, 1 August 2003-31 July 2004*).
