LETTER DATED 30 SEPTEMBER 1966 FROM THE PRESIDENT OF BOTSWANA
ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

On behalf of the Government of Botswana and in my capacity as President, I have the honour to inform you that Botswana, having today attained independence, wishes herewith to make application for membership of the United Nations with all the rights and duties attached thereto. I would accordingly be grateful if this application could be submitted to the Security Council at its next meeting. For this purpose I attach a Declaration made in pursuance of rule 58 of the Council's rules of procedure.
