The Security Council resumed its consideration of the item at its 5002nd meeting, held on 13 July 2004 in accordance with the understanding reached in its prior consultations.

In accordance with the understanding reached in the Council's prior consultations, the President, with the consent of the Council, extended an invitation under rule 39 of the Council's provisional rules of procedure to Terje Roed-Larsen, Special Coordinator for the Middle East Peace Process and Personal Representative of the Secretary-General.

The President, with the consent of the Council, invited the representative of Somalia, at his request, to participate in the discussion without the right to vote.
