Decision concerning the continuation of technical assistance to Iraq taken by the Governing Council
of the United Nations Compensation Commission at its 137th meeting, on 2 July 2004

The Governing Council,

Having considered the request made by the Permanent Mission of the Republic of Iraq for the continuation of funding for the provision of technical assistance to Iraq in the outstanding review of the fourth and fifth instalments of “F4” environmental claims, pursuant to Governing Council decision 124 (S/AC.26/Dec.124 (2001)), in an amount of US\$4 million,

Recalling its previous decisions to continue technical assistance to Iraq for the review of environmental claims,

Understanding that this should be the final such request to come before the Council,

1. Decides, that the amount of US\$4 million be allocated for the purpose of technical assistance to Iraq in the outstanding review of the fourth and fifth instalments of “F4” environmental claims, under the conditions set out in the annex to decision 124,

2. Decides also that the amount of US\$4 million be funded out of the available funds in the Commission’s operating reserve.
