INADIMISSIBILITY OF THE POLICY OF HEGEMONISM IN INTERNATIONAL RELATIUNS

Union of Soviet Socialist Republics: draft resolution

## The General Assernbly,

Considering that the most important task of the United Nations at the present stage of the development of international relations is to promote in every way positive movenent towards easing international tension and strengthening peace,

Expressing its conviction that the interests of continuing and deepening the process of normalization and development of relations between States require strict observance by all States of the principles on which the United Nations is based,

Noting that the policy of hegenonism, i.e. the desire of some States to dominate other States and peoples, is in flagrant contradictior to those principles: first and foremost the principle of the sovereign equality of States,

Recalling that the policy of hegemonism has invariably led to wars which have brought untold suffering to mankind,

Recalling further that manifestations of the policy of hegemonism lead to the creation of hotbeds of tension, complicate relations between States and destabilize the international situation,

1. Resolutely condemns the policy of hegemonism, whatever the form in which it is inanifested, as incompatible with the fundamental principles of the Charter of the United jations and with the task of preserving peace and strengthening international security;
2. Declares on behalf of the peoples of the United Nations that States or groups of States should never, under any circumstances and for any reasons whats eever, claim hegemony in international affairs or seek a position of doninauion either in the world as a whole or in any of its regions.
