CABLE DATED 12 DECEMBER 1965 FROM THE PRESIDENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF KENYA ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-CEMEPAL OF THE UNITED MATIONS

Kenya Government deeply concerned about continued rebellion in Rhodesia Stop We are doubtful about success of voluntary sanctions Stop The situation is desperate and dangerous with threat of racial confrontation on world scale Stop Kenya proposes immediate calling Security Council to approve sanctions under Chapter 7 - by this we mean mandatory sanction Stop Britain must be made to accept this Stop
