Bolivia. Ivory Coast, Jordan, Malaysia, Netherlands, Uruguay:
joint draft resolution

The Security Council,

Noting that the Report of the Secretary-General (S/7001) dated 10 December 1965 states that the United Nations Peace-keeping Force is needed in Cyprus,

Noting that the Government of Cyprus has agreed that in view of the prevailing conditions in the Island the continuation of the United Nations Force is necessary beyond 26 December 1965,

1. Reaffirms its resolutions of 4 March, 13 March, 20 June, 9 August (S/5868), 25 September and 18 December 1964, the consensus expressed by the then President on 11 August 1964 and the further resolutions of 19 March, 15 June and 10 August 1965;

2. Extends once again the stationing in Cyprus of the United Nations Peace-keeping Force established under Security Council resolution of 4 March 1964, for an additional period of three months, ending 26 March 1966.
