Summary statement by the Secretary-General on matters of which the Security Council is seized and on the stage reached in their consideration

Addendum

Pursuant to rule 11 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the Secretary-General is submitting the following summary statement.

The list of items of which the Security Council is seized is contained in documents S/2004/20 of 14 February 2004, S/2004/20/Add.4 of 5 March 2004, S/2004/20/Add.12 of 7 May 2004, S/2004/20/Add.15 of 28 May 2004; S/2004/20/Add.16 of 4 June 2004; S/2004/20/Add.20 of 2 July 2004; S/2004/20/Add.21 of 9 July 2004; S/2004/20/Add.23 of 23 July 2004; S/2004/20/Add.25 of 6 August 2004 and S/2004/20/Add.29 of 18 August 2004.

During the week ending 11 September 2004, the Security Council took action on the following items:

Meeting of the Security Council with the troop-contributing countries to the United Nations Mission in Ethiopia and Eritrea pursuant to resolution 1353 (2001), annex II, sections A and B (*see* S/2001/15/Add.37; S/2002/30/Add.10 and 32; S/2003/40/Add.10 and 36; and S/2004/20/Add.10; *see also* S/1998/44/Add.25; S/1999/25/Add.3, 5 and 7; S/2000/40/Add.18, 19, 30, 32, 36, 45 and 46; S/2001/15/Add.6, 11, 16, 20, 37 and 46; S/2002/30/Add.2, 9, 10, 19, 32 and 35; and S/2003/40/Add. 10, 28 and 36; and S/2004/20/Add.10)

The Security Council resumed its consideration of the item at its 5029th (private) meeting, held on 10 September 2004 in accordance with the understanding reached in its prior consultations.

At the close of the meeting, in accordance with rule 55 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the following communiqué was issued through the Secretary-General in place of a verbatim record:

“On 10 September 2004, the Security Council, pursuant to resolution 1353 (2001), annex II, sections A and B, held its 5029th meeting in private with the troop-contributing countries to the United Nations Mission in Ethiopia and Eritrea (UNMEE).

“The Security Council and the troop-contributing countries heard a briefing under rule 39 of its provisional rules of procedure by Legwaila Joseph

Legwaila, Special Representative of the Secretary-General for Ethiopia and Eritrea.

“Members of the Council, Mr. Legwaila and representatives of participating troop-contributing countries had a constructive exchange of views.”

The question concerning Haiti (*see S/25070/Add.24 and Corr.1, 34, 35, 37, 38, 41, 43 and 46; S/1994/20/Add.1, 11, 17, 25, 27, 30, 38, 40 and 47; S/1995/40/Add.4, 16, 30 and 45; S/1996/15/Add.8, 25, 47 and 48; S/1997/40/Add.30 and 47; S/1998/44/Add.12 and 47; S/1999/25/Add.47; S/2000/40/Add.10; and S/2004/20/Add.8, 9 and 17; see also S/22110/Add.39*).

The Security Council resumed its consideration of the item at its 5030th meeting, held on 10 September 2004 in accordance with the understanding reached in its prior consultations, having before it the report of the Secretary-General on Haiti (S/2004/698).

The President, with the consent of the Council, invited the representative of Haiti, at his request, to participate in the discussion without the right to vote.

The President stated that, following consultations of the Council, he had been authorized to make a statement on behalf of the Council, and read out the text of that statement (for the text, see S/PRST/2004/32; to be issued in *Official Records of the Security Council, Resolutions and Decisions of the Security Council, 1 August 2004-31 July 2005*).
