LETTER DATED 16 NOVEMBER 1965 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF INDIA ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

I have the honour to communicate the following further cease-fire violations and other incidents created by Pakistan:

## Jammu and Kashmir

## Gurais Sector

1. Pakistani troops were seen digging in an area six miles north-east of Gurais on 13 November 1965.

#### Keran Sector

- 2. Pakistani troops fired 4.2-inch mortars towards an area twelve and a half miles east-north-east of Keran on 12 November 1965.
- 3. Pakistani troops were seen digging trenches and constructing bunkers in an area nine miles and eleven miles east-north-east of Keran on 13 November 1965.

## <u>Tithwal Sector</u>

- 4. Pakistani troops constructed bunkers and directed medium machine-gun fire towards our post in areas four and a half miles and three and a half miles south-west of Tithwal respectively on 11 November 1965.
- 5. Pakistani troops fired medium machine-guns towards our post in an area three and a half miles south-south-west of Tithwal on 13 November 1965.

# Uri Sector

- 6. Pakistani troops were seen improving and constructing bunkers three miles south and six and a half miles south-south-west of Haji Pir Pass on 10 and 11 November 1965 respectively.
- 7. Pakistani troops were seen constructing bunkers in an area four and a half miles south-south-west of Haji Pir Pass on 12 November 1965.

## Punch Sector

- 8. Pakistani troops directed medium machine-gun and small arms fire towards our troops at three places in areas between four miles west-north-west and five miles west-south-west of Punch on 11 and 12 November 1965.
- 9. Pakistani troops fired rifle shots towards our patrol in an area four and a half miles west-north-west of Punch on the night of 12/13 November 1965.
- 10. Pakistani troops fired towards an area four and a half miles west of Punch on the night of 12/13 November 1965.

## Mendhar Sector

- 11. Pakistani troops directed 25 pounders' fire towards an area seven miles west-north-west of Mendhar and 81 mm fire towards areas five miles south-west and four and a half miles west-south-west of Galuthi on 11 and 12 November 1965.
- 12. Pakistani troops were seen constructing bunkers in an area six miles west-south-west of Mendhar on 12 November 1965. On being challenged by our troops they stopped the work.
- 13. Pakistani troops were seen laying mines and wire near their picket in an area nine and a half miles west-north-west of Mendhar on 12 November 1965.

# Naushahra Sector

- 14. Pakistani troops fired 106 mm recoilless rifle and one or two anti-tank guided missiles towards an area two and a half miles north of Jhangar on the night of 12/13 November 1965.
- 15. Pakistani troops fired 25 pounders, 3-inch mortars and medium machineguns towards five of our posts between eight and a half miles north-east and two and a half miles north-west of Jhangar on the night of 12/13 November 1965.
- 16. Some Pakistani troops intruded into our area four and a half miles north-east of Jhangar on 13 November 1965.

# Akhnur Sector

17. Pakistani troops were seen digging at five places between approximately six miles east-south-east and five miles west-south-west of Kalidhar and at one place four and a half miles north-east of Jaurian on 12 November 1965.

- 18. Pakistani troops were seen strengthening defences in the following areas on 13 November 1965:
  - (a) Two and a half miles east-north-east and three and a half miles north-east of Jaurian.
  - (b) Seven and eight miles north-north-east of Mandiala.
  - (c) Five and a half miles north-north-east of Dewa.
- 19. Pakistani troops set fire to village Battal, three and a half miles north-east of Dewa on 13 November 1965.

## Pun,jab

#### Sialkot Sector

- 20. Pakistani troops were seen digging in an area three and a half miles south-south-west of Suchetgarh and three miles west-south-west of Pagowal on 12 November 1965.
- 21. Pakistani troops were seen digging in an area four and a half miles north-north-west of Ran Bir Singh Pura and three and a half miles south-west of Pagowal on 13 November 1965.

## Lahore Sector

- 22. Pakistani troops fired small arms on our post six miles north of Ajnala on 11 November 1965.
- 23. Pakistani troops fired across water line at our post five and a half miles south-east of Rattoke on 10 November 1965 and one mile east of Ichhogil Uttar on 12 November 1965.
- 24. Approximately eighty Pakistani personnel, including twenty civilians, dismounted behind village Kalia Sankhatra, five and a half miles north-north-west of Khemkaran on 12 November 1965.
- 25. Pakistani troops were seen digging and constructing bunkers at eight places between Dograi and Farki area on 12 Movemmer 1965.
- 26. Pakistani troops fired 2-inch mortars, medium machine-guns and para flares towards an area 1,400 yards east of Jallo on the night of 12/13 November 1965.
- 27. Pakistani troops were seen digging trenches in an area 1,000 yards north-north-west of Bhasin on the night of 12/13 November 1965.

- 28. Pakistani troops fired towards Dograi and also dug trenches in an area west of Dograi on 13 November 1965.
- 29. Pakistani troops fired towards our troops in an area two and a half miles south-south-west of Earki.
- 30. Pakistani troops were seen strengthening their defences between two miles north-north-west and four miles north of Barki on 13 November 1965.
- 31. One Pakistani jeep and a three-ton lorry arrived at Hanuwal from Khemkaran on 13 November 1965. It is presumed that they brought reinforcements.
- 32. Pakistani troops brought defence stores to Kalia, five and a half miles north of Khemkaran on 13 November 1965.
- 35. One Pakistani infiltrated into our area three and a half miles north of Barki on the night of 13/14 November 1965. He fled away when challenged by our troops.

#### Fazilka Sector

- 34. Approximately eighty Pakistani troops with eight light machine-guns arrived in an area Chakk Amira three and a half miles west-north-west of Fazilka on 11 November 1965.
- 35. Pakistani troops fired three rifle shots at our observation post close to Chananwala on 11 November 1965.
- 36. Pakistani troops dug crawl trenches in Chananwala area on ll November 1965.
- 37. Pakistani patrol was seen in an area marked by United Nations as no man's land, four miles west of Fazilka on 12 November 1965.
- 38. Pakistani troops were heard digging in an area six miles south-west of Fazilka on the night of 12/13 November 1965.
- 39. Pakistani troops fired at our post in an area fifteen miles west-southwest of Ferozpore on 13 November 1965.
- 40. Pakistani troops were seen plucking cotton and cutting crops from an Indian enclave now under Pakistan's control in an area three and a half miles west-north-west of Dera Baba Nanak on 13 November 1965.

## Rajasthan

- 41. A Pakistani platoon was seen digging in an area one mile south of Ghotaru on 12 November 1965 and Pakistani patrolling activity continues south and west of Ghotaru.
- 42. Pakistani troops fired machine-guns at our post in an area twenty-four miles west-north-west of Gadra road throughout the day on 13 November 1965.
- 43. A Pakistani patrol clashed with our patrol in an area four miles south of Rohari at 0800 hours on 12 November 1965.

Cease-fire violation complaints have been or are being lodged in respect of all these violations.

I shall be grateful if this communication is circulated as a Security Council document.
