LETTER DATED 18 NOVEMBER 1965 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF HAITI ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL.

Text of the Statement by His Excellency Dr. François Duvelier, Fresident for Life of the Republic of Haiti

I have the honour to inform you that the Government of the Republic of Haiti deplores the confused situation prevailing in Southern Rhodesia to the detriment of the inalienable rights of the majority of the people who in fact constitute the nation, invoking the unalterable and historical ties which bind the first free Negro Republic in the world to the African continent. I assure you of the moral and material support of my Government for any draft resolution introduced by a Member State or any resolution of the Security Council aimed at guaranteeing respect for and the dignity of the majority of the Rhodesian people. I should be grateful if you would have my statement circulated as an official document of the United Nations.
