LETTER DATED 22 NOVEMBER 1965 FROM THE REPRESENTATIVES OF LIBERIA,
MADAGASCAR, SIERRA LEONE AND TUNISIA ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT
OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

We have the honour to refer to the requests contained in documents S/6584 of 2 August 1965 and S/6791 of 15 October 1965, concerning the discussion by the Security Council of the policy of apartheid of the Government of South Africa.

In view of the serious situation prevailing at present in Southern Rhodesia and the implications it will certainly have on the question of apartheid to be discussed in the Security Council, we request you to defer the debate on this question to a later date.
