LETTER DATED 30 OCTOBER 1965 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF GREECE
ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

Following my letter No. P3365-154 dated 12 October 1965, I have the honour to inform Your Excellency that on 27 October 1965 two jet aircraft violated Greek air space in the region of the Dodecanese Islands. All indications point to the fact that they belong to the Turkish air force, and my Government has lodged a formal protest with the Turkish Government.

The violation took place as follows:

At 1240 hours, local time, the two aircraft were observed flying over the island of Rhodes, at a height of 1,000 feet.

At 1253 hours, local time, they were flying over the airport of Kephalos, in the island of Kos.

At 1256 hours, local time, they circled over the town of Kalymnos, and finally changing course disappeared in the direction of the Turkish coast.

I would appreciate it if Your Excellency would have this letter reproduced as a document of the Security Council.
