Official communiqué of the 5054th (closed) meeting of the Security Council**Held in private at Headquarters, New York, on Friday, 8 October 2004, at 3 p.m.**

In accordance with rule 55 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the following communiqué was issued through the Secretary-General in place of a verbatim record:

“On 8 October 2004, the Security Council, pursuant to annex II, sections A and B of resolution 1353 (2001), held its 5054th meeting in private with the troop-contributing countries to the United Nations Peacekeeping Force in Cyprus (UNFICYP).

“The Security Council and the troop-contributing countries heard a briefing under rule 39 of its provisional rules of procedure by Mr. Zbigniew Wlosowicz, Acting Special Representative of the Secretary-General for Cyprus and Chief of Mission.

“Members of the Council, Mr. Wlosowicz and representatives of participating troop-contributing countries had a constructive exchange of views.”
