LETTER DATED 19 CCTOBER 1965 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF INDIA ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

I have the honour to communicate the following further cease-fire violations and other incidents created by Pakistan.

Jammu and Kashmir

Keran Sector

1. Pakistani troops directed medium machine-gun and mortar fire towards the areas four and a half miles and seven and a half miles south scuth-west of Keren on 16 October 1965.

Tithwal Sector

- 2. Pakistani troops directed medium machine-gun and mortar fire towards the following areas on 16 October 1965:
- (a) Two places between seven and a half miles to eight miles north of Tangdhar.
 - (b) Two and a half miles south of Tithwal.

Mendhar Sector

- 5. Thirty-five Pakistani troops were seen constructing bunkers in an area ten and a half miles west north-west of Mendhar on 15 October 1965.
- 4. Pakistani troops were seen constructing bunkers in an area five and a half miles south of Mendhar on 17 October 1965.

Naushahra Sector

5. Pakistani troops were seen digging trenches in an area two and a half miles north-west of Jhangar at 1000 hours on 17 October 1965.

Akhnur Sector

- 5. Pakistani troops were seen digging and laying wire in areas Eor, six miles east south-east and Dager seven miles east of Balwinder bridge respectively on 16 October 1965.
- 7. One section of Pakistani troops was observed cutting dry trees in an area three miles cast south-east of Balwinder bridge at 1200 hours on 17 October 1965.
- 8. Seven Pakistani troops were observed in an area one mile south of Point 3776, and one and a half miles east of Balwinder bridge at 0600 hours on 17 October 1965. They withdrew on being challenged by our patrol.

Punjab

Sialkot Sector

- 9. Five Pakistani troops were observed digging trenches in an area three miles north north-west of Suchetgarh on 17 October 1965.
- 10. Eight Pakistani troops were observed digging in an area nine and a half miles north north-west of Ranbirsinghpura on 17 Octobe. 1965.

Lahore Sector

- 11. Pakistani troops directed medium machine-gun and mortar fire intermittently towards our post at Rajoke three miles east scuth-east of Bedian on the night of 15/17 October 1965.
- 12. One Pakistani three-ton vehicle carrying defence stores arrived at Barki bridge and moved along the west bank of Ichhogil Canal distributing the stores at 0820 hours on 17 October 1965.
- 15. One Pakistani fifteen cwt. vehicle brought defence stores in an area half a mile west of Barki on 17 October 1965 and again on 18 October 1965.
- 14. Pakistani troops were seen digging in areas between one mile to two miles north of Barki on 17 October 1965.
- 15. Pakistani troops laid wire in areas between two miles to two and a half miles south south-east of Jallo on 17 October 1965.
- 16. Pakistani troops continued strengthening their defences in areas between two and a half miles to three and a half miles south of Barki on 17 October 1965.

17. Pakistani troops were seen constructing bunkers with overhead cover in an area two miles south-east of Jallo on 17 October 1965.

Fazilka Sector

18. A Pakistani patrol intruded within 400 yards of cur position in an area six miles south south-west of Fazilka and fired at our patrol at 0500 on 17 October 1965.

Cease-fire violation complaints have been or are being lodged in respect of all these violations.

I shall be grateful if this communication is circulated as a Security Council document.
