LETTER DATED 10 NOVEMBER 1965 FROM THE SECRETARY OF STATE FOR
FOREIGN AFFAIRS OF TUNISIA ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE
SECURITY COUNCIL

On the instructions of my Government, I have the honour to inform you of my desire to participate on behalf of Tunisia, in accordance with Article 32 of the Charter and rule 37 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, in the Council's discussion of the question of apartheid in South Africa, the subject of the request appearing in documents S/6534 of 2 August 1965 and S/6791 of 15 October 1965, and I should be glad if you would accordingly be good enough to place the name of Tunisia on the list of speakers.
