LETTER DATED 11 NOVEMBER 1965 ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL BY THE REPRESENTATIVES OF AFGHANISTAN, CEYLON, CYPRUS, GHANA, INDIA, IRAN, IRAQ, JORDAN, KUWAIT, LIBYA, MADAGASCAR, MAURITANIA, MOROCCO, PAKISTAN, PHILIPPINES, SIERRA LEONE, SOMALIA, SUDAN, SYRIA, THAILAND, TURKEY AND UGANDA

On the instructions of our respective Governments, we have the honour to request you to convene an urgent meeting of the Security Council to consider the grave situation in Rhodesia arising out of the unilateral declaration of independence by the white minority Government of that Territory.

Our Governments are convinced that the unilateral declaration of independence aggravates an already explosive situation and threatens international peace and security.
