LETTER DATED 11 NOVEMBER 1965 FROM THE PRESIDENT OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY
ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

I have the honour to transmit to you herewith the text of resolution 2024 (XX) on Southern Rhodesia, which was adopted by the General Assembly at its 1375th plenary meeting, on 11 November 1965.

In adopting this resolution, the General Assembly, in operative paragraph 3, "recommends the Security Council to consider this situation as a matter of urgency".

The General Assembly,

Considering the explosive situation created in Southern Rhodesia following the unilateral declaration of independence,

Noting the measures taken by the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland,

1. Condemns the unilateral declaration of independence made by the racist minority in Southern Rhodesia;
2. Invites the United Kingdom to implement immediately the relevant resolutions adopted by the General Assembly and the Security Council, to put an end to the rebellion by the unlawful authorities in Southern Rhodesia;
3. Recommends the Security Council to consider this situation as a matter of urgency.
