INDIAN PLAN TO VIOLATE CEASE-FIRE IN JAMMU & KASHMIR

Attached herewith is a photostat copy of an Indian document captured during the recent fighting in Jammu and Kashmir. It is a Skeleton Operational Order by Commanding Officer of 4th Battalion, the Kumaon Regiment for the destruction of JURA bridge, in Tithwal area in the State of Jammu and Kashmir. The attack on this bridge, located well within Pakistan side of cease fire line, commenced as would be seen from the Operational Order on 6 October 1965, while the ceasefire came into effect on 23 September, 1965.

The operation in question was conceived and planned at the highest level and entrusted to the 19th Infantry Division of the Indian Army for execution. The General Officer Commanding 19th Infantry Division was ordered to clear the bulge east of River Kishenganga and thence dominate the River line. He was further ordered to destroy the bridge at Jura. The General Officer employed one briggede consisting, besides the 4th Rumaon, of 1st Sikh and 3rd Sikh Estalions to carry out the task.


The tasks allotted by the Brigade Commander to each battalion were as under:-

| 4th Kumaon Regiment - | destruction of bridge at Jura map reference NL 858582 by last light 6 October 1965. |
|-----------------------|---|
| 3rd Sikh Battalion - | destruction of second bridge in the North. |
| lst Sikh Battalion | destruction of first bridge at Whyderi. |

The operation order throws sufficient light on how the Kumaon carried out its mission and what artillery support, including medium, field and mountain guns - was available to the for the purpose.

It also brings out that helicopters were used for logistic support.

This document clearly brings out that India had accepted the cease fire with mental reservations. It also proves that they are attempting to seize areas under Pakistan control at the time of the cease fire.
