

## Summary statement by the Secretary-General on matters of which the Security Council is seized and on the stage reached in their consideration

## Addendum

Pursuant to rule 11 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the Secretary-General is submitting the following summary statement.

The list of items of which the Security Council is seized is contained in documents S/2004/20 of 14 February 2004, S/2004/20/Add.4 of 5 March 2004, S/2004/20/Add.12 of 7 May 2004, S/2004/20/Add.15 of 28 May 2004, S/2004/20/Add.16 of 4 June 2004, S/2004/20/Add.20 of 2 July 2004, S/2004/20/Add.21 of 9 July 2004, S/2004/20/Add.23 of 23 July 2004, S/2004/20/Add.25 of 6 August 2004, S/2004/20/Add.29 of 18 August 2004 and S/2004/20/Add.38 of 28 September 2004.

During the week ending 2 October 2004, the Security Council, at its 5044th meeting, held on 28 September 2004, considered its draft report to the General Assembly covering the period from 1 August 2003 to 31 July 2004.

The Security Council adopted the draft report, as corrected, without a vote, and the decision was reflected in a note by the President of the Council (S/2004/743).

Also during the week ending 2 October 2004, the Security Council took action on the following items:

The Security Council resumed its consideration of the item at its 5045th meeting, held on 28 September 2004 in accordance with the understanding reached in its prior consultations.

The President, with the consent of the Council, invited the representative of Afghanistan, at his request, to participate in the discussion without the right to vote.

In accordance with the understanding reached in the Council's prior consultations, the President, with the consent of the Council, extended an invitation under rule 39 of the Council's provisional rules of procedure to Jean-Marie Guéhenno, Under-Secretary-General for Peacekeeping Operations.

**Report of the Secretary-General on the Sudan** (*see* S/2004/20/Add.23, 30, 35 and 37; *see also* S/2003/40/Add.40; and S/2004/20/Add.21)

The Security Council resumed its consideration of the item at its 5046th (private) meeting, held on 30 September 2004 in accordance with the understanding reached in its prior consultations.

At the close of the meeting, in accordance with rule 55 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the following communiqué was issued through the Secretary-General in place of a verbatim record:

"At its 5046th meeting, held in private on 30 September 2004, the Security Council considered the item entitled 'Report of the Secretary-General on the Sudan'.

"His Excellency Mustafa Osman Ismail, the distinguished Minister for Foreign Affairs of the Sudan, was invited, in response to his request, to participate in the discussion, in accordance with rule 37 of the Council's provisional rules of procedure.

"The Security Council heard a briefing by Mr. Mustafa Osman Ismail.

"Members of the Council and Mr. Mustafa Osman Ismail had a constructive exchange of views."

The Security Council resumed its consideration of the item at its 5047th meeting, held on 1 October 2004 in accordance with the understanding reached in its prior consultations, having before it a letter dated 21 September 2004 from the Secretary-General addressed to the President of the Security Council (S/2004/764).

The President stated that, in the absence of objection, the Security Council agreed that the President should send the reply as drafted to the letter dated 21 September 2004 from the Secretary-General.

The reply would be issued as a document of the Council under the symbol S/2004/765.

The Security Council resumed its consideration of the item at its 5048th meeting, held on 1 October 2004 in accordance with the understanding reached in its prior consultations, having before it the third special report of the Secretary-General on the United Nations Organization Mission in the Democratic Republic of the Congo (S/2004/650) and a letter dated 3 September 2004 from the Secretary-General addressed to the President of the Security Council (S/2004/715).

The President, with the consent of the Council, invited the representative of the Democratic Republic of the Congo, at his request, to participate in the discussion without the right to vote.

The President drew attention to a draft resolution (S/2004/774) that had been prepared in the course of the Council's prior consultations.

The Security Council proceeded to vote on draft resolution S/2004/774, and adopted it unanimously as resolution 1565 (2004) (for the text, see S/RES/1565 (2004); to be issued in *Official Records of the Security Council, Resolutions and Decisions of the Security Council, 1 August 2004-31 July 2005*).
