LETTER DATED 13 OCTOBER 1965 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF PAKISTAN
ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

I have been instructed by my Government to inform you of the following violations of the cease-fire by Indian forces:

- (i) Indian forces fired with machine guns on one of our aircraft flying well within our territory in area 2159 at 1725 hours on 9 October 1965.
- (ii) Indian forces fired with machine guns on our positions in area 2258 and 2357 at 1730 hours on 9 October 1965.
- (iii) Indian forces launched a heavy attack supported by intensive shelling with medium artillery on Ghotaru IA 76 on the evening of 12 October 1965. Early this morning the Indian Air Force was also brought into action against our troops.

2. UNIPOM has been informed of these violations.

3. I have been directed to draw Your Excellency's particular attention to the fact that the Indians have used their Air Force for the third time in this sector. There is no doubt that they are following a deliberate and systematic plan to seize territory which has been under our control since before the cease-fire came into effect. If they persist in their offensive, our forces will be forced to use all the resources at their command to counteract Indian aggression.

4. I shall be grateful if this letter is circulated as a Security Council document.
