LETTER DATED 14 OCTOBER 1965 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF PAKISTAN
ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

I have been instructed by my Government to inform you of the following cease-fire violations by Indian forces:

- (i) An Indian officer, accompanied by soldiers carrying a wireless set, was observed placing a white flag eighty yards ahead of their standing patrols located at Grid Reference 937778, 962774, 964770 and 957778 at 0645 hours on 12 October 1965. They were given one hour by our forces to withdraw and restore the flag to its original position. The Indian troops did so. This incident clearly establishes the technique of the Indians to creep forward in an attempt to retrieve the territory lost to us.
- (ii) Indian troops moved forward from area Kherani 40 K QP Square 1562 towards point 235 in Square 1459 at 1730 hours on 11 October 1965 and started digging there.
- (iii) Indian forces are building up their forward locations in GR 922703 from platoon to company strength and are trying to creep forward.
- (iv) Indian soldiers pitched two tents far apart in area GR 972703 40 K QA in territory under our control and have further reinforced their troops in this area.
- (v) Indian troops were observed digging trenches at GR 957778 and 963770 40 K QA. They are also reinforcing their positions in this area.

UNIPOM has been informed of these violations.

I shall be grateful if this letter is circulated as a Security Council document.
