LETTER DATED 15 OCTOBER 1965 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF PAKISTAN
ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

I have the honour to inform you of the following violations of the cease-fire by Indian forces:

- (i) Indian troops burnt down Village Hanjli Alipur near Zafarwal in Sialkot Sector at 0915 hours on 12 October 1965.
- (ii) Indians again tried to dig trenches along the BRB Canal in the Bedian area in Ferozepur-Kasur Sector at 0700 hours on 13 October 1965.
- (iii) Indian forces infiltrated into villages Kathejopar and Lalubhill in Rajasthan Sector behind Pakistan lines. They set fire to the villages and kidnapped six Pakistan civilians.
- (iv) Indians demolished civilian houses in Sialkot Sector with the object of using galvanized iron sheets for military purposes on 14 October 1965.
- (v) At Kharian in the Lahore Sector the Indians tried to demolish civilian houses to use the material for constructing bunkers.
- (vi) Indian forces fired on our positions near Burki in Lahore Sector with artillery, mortars, tank guns and automatic weapons from early morning till 1345 hours on 14 October 1965. They again tried to dig trenches in No Man's Land in this area.

All the above violations have been reported to UNIFOM.

I have been instructed by my Government to further inform you that the Indian forces fired on our positions in Lathitilla area in East Pakistan from 0300 hours to 1200 hours on 14 October 1965. They also opened fire with light machine-guns in Jessore area in East Pakistan at 0730 hours on 14 October 1965.

I shall be grateful if this letter is circulated as a Security Council document.
